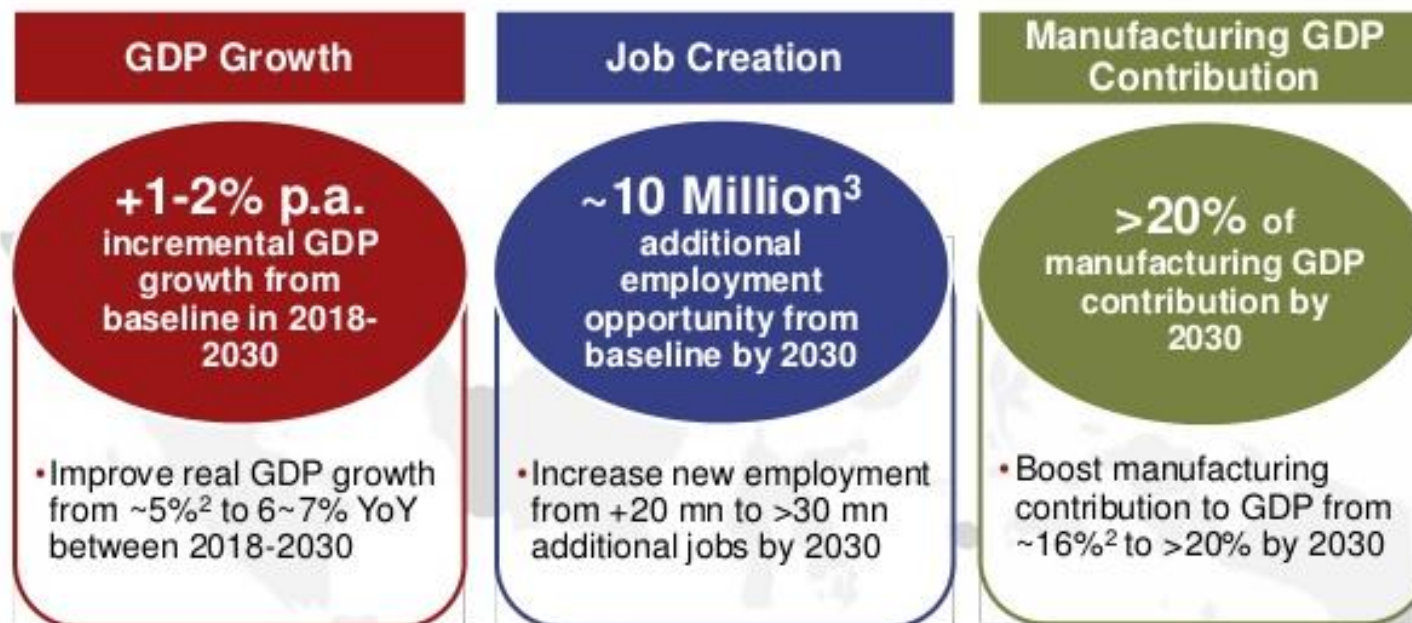

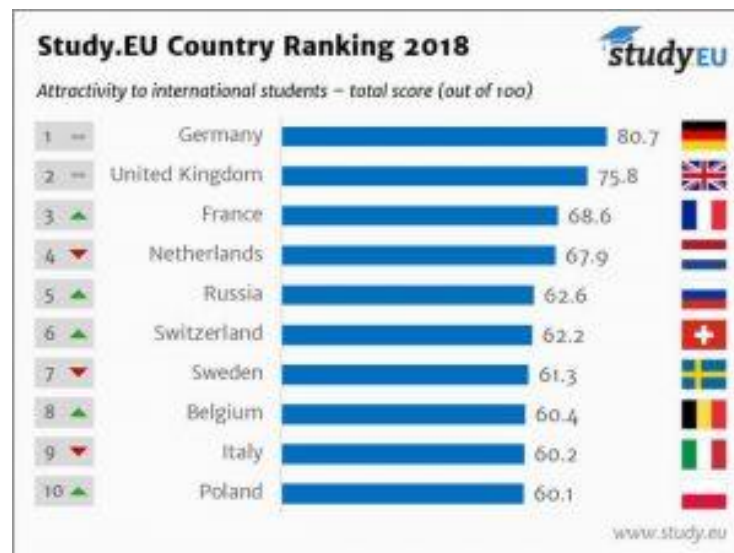

What's the objective of GDVET?

Responding to the demand of German and Indonesian companies in Indonesia to support them in their efforts to qualify and employ skilled personnel according to the German vocational education standards.

What's the advantage of GDVET in comparison to Internship?

- GDVET: Practice 21 months of 3 years total duration (60%)
- Internship: Practice 3 – 12 months of 3 years total duration (8% - 33%)

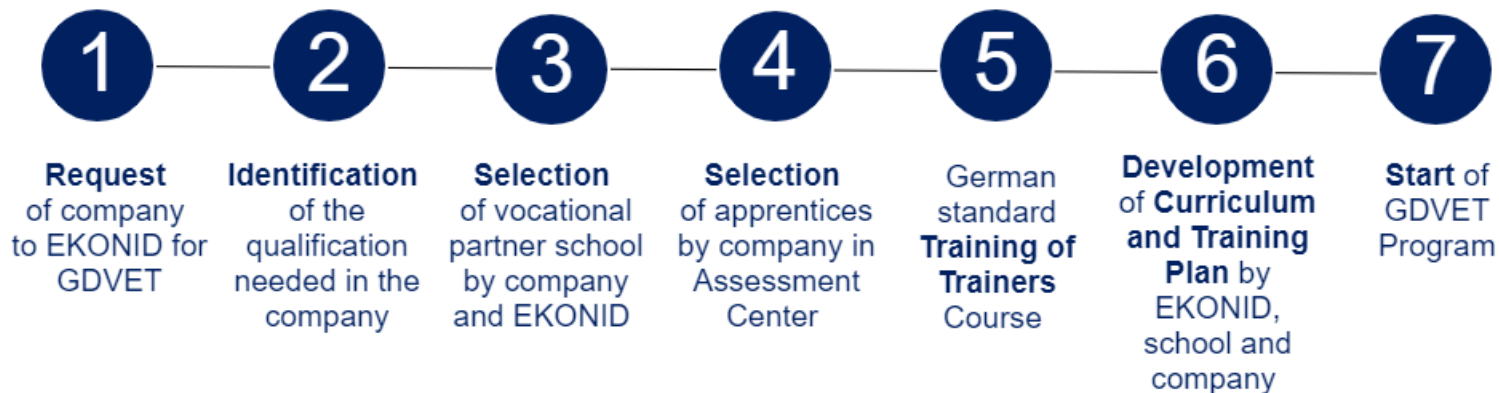
